Scientific name: *Vitis vinifera*

Botanical Family: Vitaceae

Center of origin: Western Asia

Center of production: USA

Acres in production Worldwide: 20,000,000 acres

Growing Season: Summer

Bearing Age: 2-3 after planted

Life expectancy: 8-10 years

Harvest: September-October

Soils: Deep, well drained soil

Yield: 30 lb/arbor

Fertilizer Requirements: 75 pounds of nitrogen, 40-60 pounds of phosphorous, and 200 pounds of potassium per acre per year
